Here is the present text of the recommendations on Lecturers.

The Lecturer position is a temporary, one-year or one-semester non-tenure accruing appointment, with the possibility of renewal.

A person first hired as a Lecturer for the 1984-85 long session, or after that, may serve in the position of Lecturer no more than a total of six long-session semesters at full time.

Anyone currently serving as a Lecturer may serve no more than fourteen long-session semesters at full time in the English Department.

Hiring decisions will be made on merit. Priorities shall be as follows:

1. New University of Texas English Department Ph.D.'s.
2. Former Lecturers.
3. New applicants.
