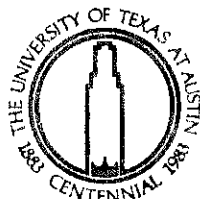

Dear Steve:

The new catalog for the College of Natural Sciences contains significant changes in the B.A. plan I. These changes will effect, on a reasonably short time scale, all incoming upper division transfer students. I enclose a copy of the memo from Bill Sutherland to Dean Robert King discussing his recommendation on how to process these students this Fall.

The first three items deal with credit for English courses and we would have no difficulty agreeing with these recommendations. We would delay the implementation of four and five which deal with the "substantial writing requirement" until after a review by the College Committee or the University Committee, as appropriate, which would provide us a list of acceptable courses for the substantial writing component. In the meantime, we will recommend to all students that they defer taking their courses to meet this writing requirement until the Spring semester. If for some reason or other a student is unable to schedule courses in this fashion, and is capable of meeting the degree requirements for Spring or Summer graduation, we would handle on a case by case basis petitions for course substitution for the courses approved by the College Committee or University Committee. There should only be a hand full of petitions, and these few would be reviewed by Dr. James Vick in our office.
