

Proposal to amend the regulations  
governing the Provisional Admissions Program

The rules governing course selection by provisionally admitted students need to be changed to reflect changes in courses and requirements made by the English Department. E306 is now the only entry level English course. E316K which comes next in the English sequence has a prerequisite of 27 credit hours and hence is not available to provisionally admitted students. It also seems desirable to make explicit the policy on repetition of courses by students continuing on provisional status.

Proposal 1. Amend the General Information Bulletin, 1984-85, Provisional admissions program, regulation 2, page 38 as follows.

Delete the paragraph

One of these courses must be in English. The specific course will be determined by the Department of English on the basis of the student's performance on a placement examination.

Replace it with the following

All students must register for E306 unless they already have credit for E306 or qualify for credit on the basis of a placement examination.

Amend the first clause in the next paragraph to read

The remaining three or four courses must be chosen from at least three of the following four groups.

Proposal 2. Amend the General Information Bulletin, 1984-85, Provisional admissions program, regulation 4, page 39 as follows.

After the first sentence "...twelve semester hours of courses as provided in item 2 above", insert the sentence.

Repeating a course other than E306 will require express written permission from the Dean of the College of Liberal Arts.
